# Rice exports cross record \$11 bn

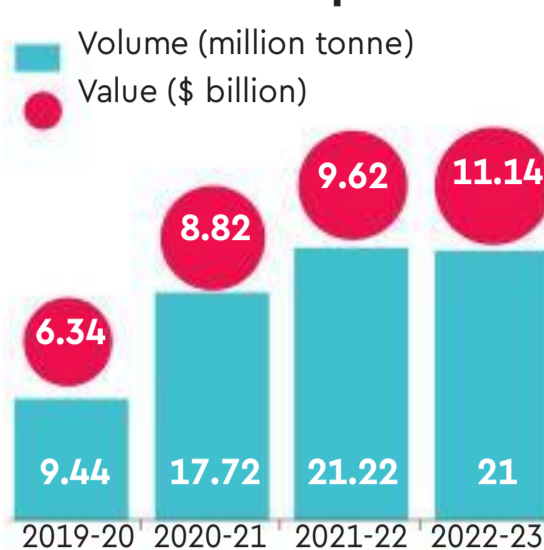

INDIA'S RICE EXPORTS have crossed a record \$11 billion in 2022-23, an increase of 16% from FY22. The volume of shipment, however, remained around the same level as last year at 21 million tonne (MT).

Officials attribute the spike in rice exports to factors such as robust global demand, especially from West Asian countries, Africa and Europe, and flood that hit a large chunk of paddy crop in Pakistan, a major grain exporter.

In FY22, India, which has an around 45% share in global rice trade, exported more than 21 MT of rice valued at \$9.6 billion. The increased realisation in rice exports has been achieved despite India last year ban-

ning broken rice shipment and the imposition of exports tax of 20% on white rice.

According to preliminary estimates, India has shipped \$11.14 billion of rice, which includes basmati (\$5 billion) and non-basmati (\$6.14 bil-

lion) during FY23. In terms of volume, the country has exported 4.9 MT of aromatic and long grain basmati and 16.1 MT of non-basmati rice. India annually exports 4.5-5 MT of basmati rice and has an 80% share in the global trade

of aromatic rice.

"Demand for rice has been robust because of resumption of shipment to Iran and spike in demand in Gulf countries especially from Saudi Arabia, Iran, UAE and others for the ongoing Ramadan months," K

All India Rice Exporters' Association, told FE. India has been the world's largest exporter of rice since 2012. Currently, India exports more rice than the combined shipments of the next three largest exporters — Thailand, Vietnam and Pakistan.

The United States department of agriculture (USDA), in its April 2023 crop outlook, has stated, "India's prices are the most competitive among global suppliers and its total supply of rice is near-record high." It has also stated that

India's price quotes for 5% broken-kernel rice were reported at \$434 this month and are virtually unchanged since late January.

"Competitive pricing has ensured a surge in rice exports in the last fiscal and adherence to export norms has resulted in a significant demand for Indian rice with the grain being shipped to more than 75 countries," M Angamuthu, chairman, Agricultural and Processed Food Products Development Authority, said.

In September, India had imposed a ban on broken rice exports and put a 20% export tariff on the non-basmati and non-parboiled rice, a measure aimed at improving domestic supplies due to the expectation of a decline in production in the 2022-23 crop season (July-June).

# MSP wheat purchases 23% less y-o-y on late harvest

WHEAT PROCUREMENT BY the Food Corporation of India (FCI) and state government agencies is 23% less on year at 4.16 million tonne (MT) in the current season (April-June) since the operations commenced from April 1.

Ashok K Meena, chairman and MD, FCI, told FE that the procurement operations have been delayed because of late harvesting, especially in Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan. The crops have been hit in these states by the recent unseasonal rains.

According to official data, 9.19 MT of wheat has arrived in the key market till April 16. The minimum support price



(MSP) operations have picked up pace in Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh. At 2.32 MT, Madhya Pradesh has been the biggest contributor to wheat procurement so far followed by Punjab (1.07 MT) and Haryana (0.72 MT).

"In the next one week or so, wheat procurement is expected to cross 8 MT as harvesting of crops has gathered pace because of the warmer climate in the last one week or so," a food ministry official said.

The government is aiming to procure 34 MT of wheat in the current season to bolster stock, which plummeted to 8.4 MT on April 1, lowest since 2016.

Officials said that MSP operations have also been delayed because of issues associated with payment to farmers as the Punjab and Haryana governments have decided to compensate the farmers against value cut imposed by the food ministry under relaxed procurement norms for grains which are shriveled, broken and have lustre loss.

Last week, the food ministry allowed purchase of shriveled and broken grain up to 18% from farmers with prescribed value cut against existing limit of 6% in Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan.

In any event, any purported transfer under the Framework Agreement was contingent upon RIPL performing its obligations under the Framework Agreement, thus, even prior to the termination of the Framework Agreement, RIPL had no rights in CCIL's factories and/or its trademarks whatsoever.
